

1. If your child is not participating in MOC activities or has been dismissed from MOC activities **REMEMBER** this: Kingdom Law states, "All children are to be supervised at all times by an adult. Children under the age of 12 must be within sight or voice range of a responsible adult/teenager at all time." Failure to do so may result in sanctions ranging from expulsion from the site up to and including notification of mundane authorities depending on the circumstances.
2. MOC ACTIVITIES IS NOT A BABYSITTING SERVICE.
3. MOC activities are for children 5 years of age and older. Children under this age require much more attention and normally do not have the attention span or motor skills for most children's activities. Children under 5 may participate if a parent/guardian is present at all times. Children whom are 5 years old and above must be self-toileting.
4. All children must wear wristbands given at troll (worn on the wrist and visible at all times) If the wristband is not present at sign in, then your child cannot participate in MOC activities until the wristband is produced and secured so that it does not fall off during activities.
5. All children attending MOC activities must be signed in and out by designated adult/guardian, an older sibling does not count. Parent/guardian should make their way toward MOC activity area at least 10 minutes before the end of the final activity to ensure prompt pick-up time.
6. Any children disrupting an activity will be given two warnings before dismissal for the day. The first warning will be verbal and the second will be an age appropriate time out. If these two corrective techniques do not work, then your child will not be able to participate in MOC activities for the remainder of the day and will be sent back to you. Again, this is per day.
7. The MOC does not serve meals. It remains up to the parent/guardian to ensure that their children are fed. Water will be available during MOC activities. This does not exclude a group or household from sponsoring a meal for the children in a separate area, but the MOC will not be responsible for delivering, serving and/or retrieving the children.
8. Parent(s)/Guardian/Designated Adult is expected to pledge an hour per child per day to assist with children's activities. A history of parent participation will allow expanded children's activities for future events. Those who are unable to meet this rule are strongly advised to contact the local MOC prior to the event.
